## Act of Presence of God

- 1. 'Receive the Holy Spirit' (John 20:22). Do I believe that God the Father has taken possession of my life in Baptism, incorporated me into Christ's life and sent the Holy Spirit?
- 2. Do I realise that Christian life implies a constant dialogue with the Trinity, and that the Holy Spirit leads me to that joyful intimacy? Do I have recourse to the Holy Spirit in prayer to help me identify with and share all mankind's noble aspirations, and to sanctify my own life?
- 3. To work with the freedom Christ has won for us, do I desire to strip myself of selfishness, of all reliance on material security, and truly live by faith?
- 4. Do I value spiritual direction as a school to get to know Christ better? Do I open my heart in all frankness to seek the light of the Holy Spirit? Do I accept responsibly the advice I get, realising that it is up to me to decide what to do?
- 5. Do I read and meditate on the Gospel to contemplate how Christ behaved during his hidden life and ensure that my work is a worthy offering, pleasing to God?
- 6. Does my work naturally lead me to God, or in practice do I regard it as unrelated to my Christian life? Do I realise that with the help of God's grace and using common sense, I have to find the right balance amid my different responsibilities?
- 7. Do I lovingly take care of the work of the home, knowing it to be an important task?
- 8. "Fear not, therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows" (Matt 10:31). When life is particularly tough (work problems, unemployment, etc.), do I place myself in God's hands? Do I ask him to give me peace, to shorten the trials, and to help me do whatever I should to resolve them?
- 9. In this month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, do I ask him to give me a good heart, capable of feeling others' suffering, one that can alleviate their anxieties with the balm of charity?
- 10. Do I have recourse to St Josemaría, "the Saint of ordinary life", to bring light and joy into my family, my work and my friendships? Am I familiar with his life, and do I meditate on his writings?
- 11. St Josemaría has particular fondness for me because I receive formation from the Work he founded by God's Will. What can I do to spread devotion to him?
- 12. Do I ask St Josemaría to help me in my apostolate to love my friends and speak to them courageously about God, without putting them under pressure?
- 13. Do I bring my heart to the Sweet and Immaculate Heart of Mary, so that She purifies me and leads me to the Sacred and Merciful Heart of Jesus?
